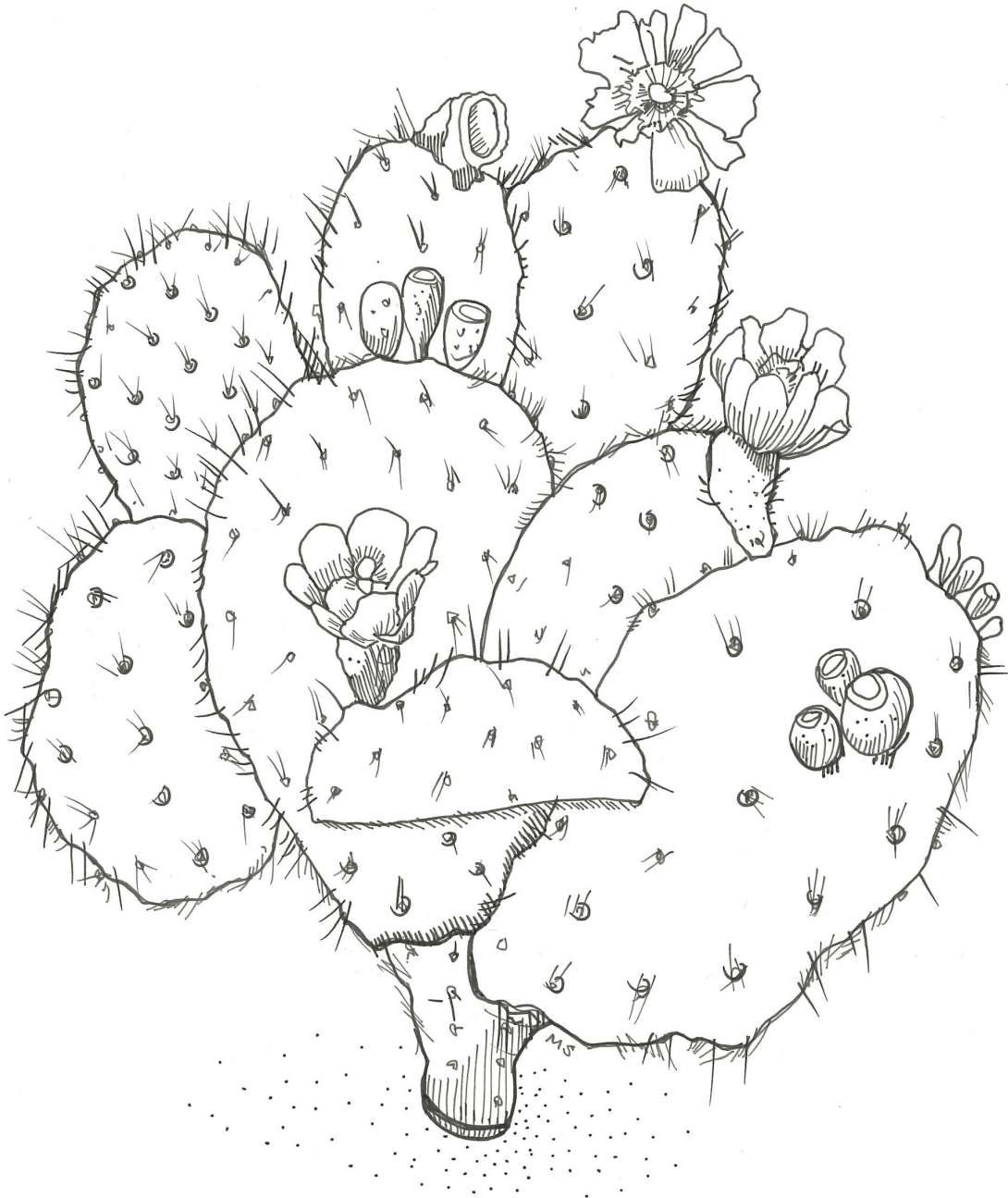


PRICKLY PEAR CACTUS

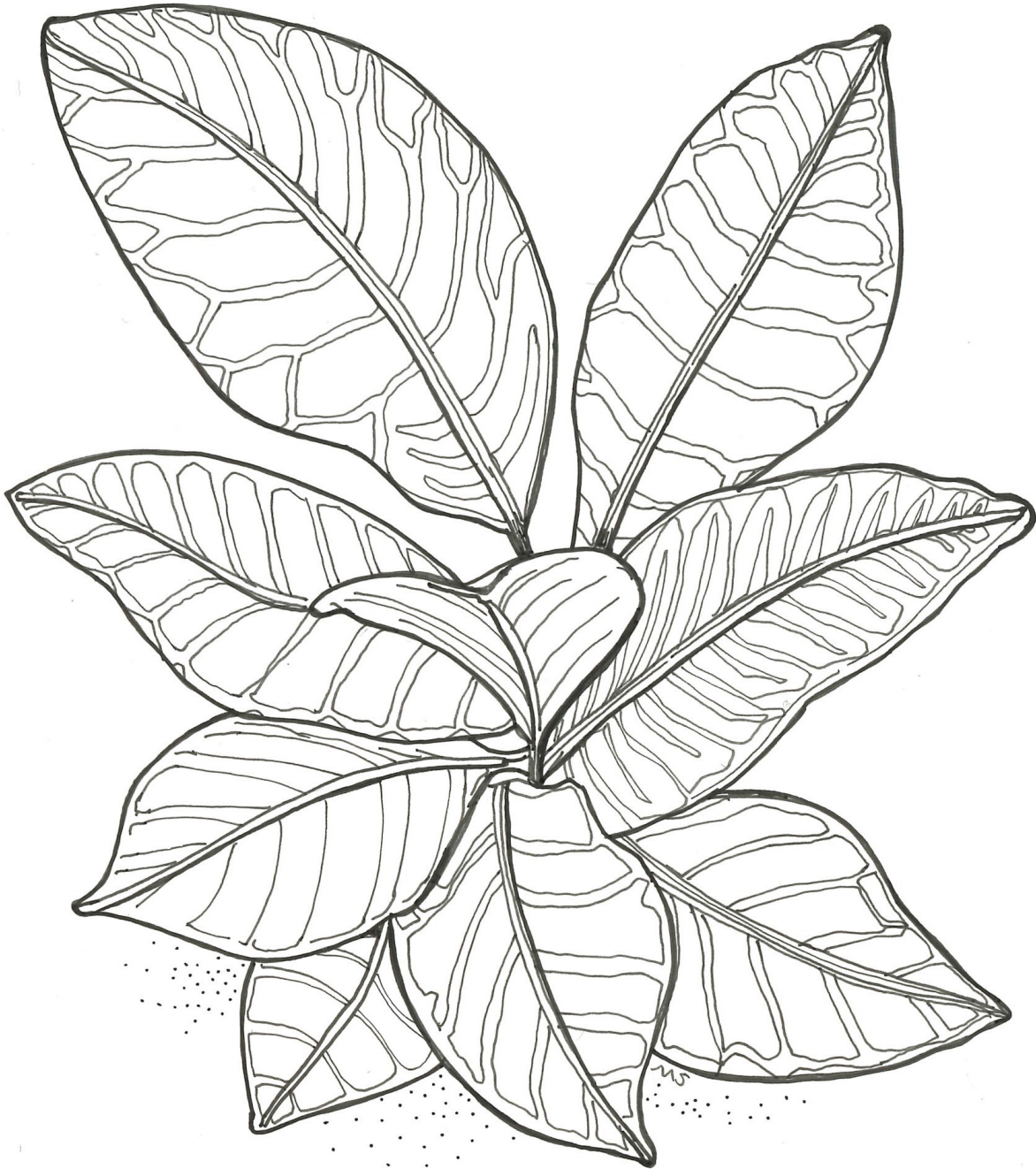
